Dear Downtown Residents and Businesses,

The Troy Strawberry Festival office and the City of Troy want to be sure that all downtown residents and businesses are aware of the layout and closure schedule for the 2024 festival. The festival this year will encompass the downtown circle and stretch along Main Street from Plum Street to Mulberry Street, and down-Market Street from Water Street to Franklin.

Schedule:

Strawberry Jam (Hometown Celebration) on Friday May 31 - 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm

Saturday June 1 - 10:00 am to 9:00 pm

Sunday June 2 - 10:00 am to 6:00 pm

We would like to make every effort to ensure the safety of not only the festival guests, but also the business and residents of the downtown community. In this effort, it is necessary to close certain streets for the festival. The following is a list of streets that are closing and the time/dates in which they will be closing:

Street Closures:

Beginning Thursday, May 30th at 5:00 pm:

- North Cherry Street (between Main and Water)
- The quadrants downtown and parking spaces along Market Street (between Franklin Street and Water Street)
- Main Street (between Mulberry Street and Plum Street)
- The entire downtown area will be closed to all traffic. Main Street (Between Plum and Mulberry), Market Street (between Water Street and Franklin Street), South Cherry (between Main Street and Franklin Street)

North Market Street Bridge will be closed on Friday, May 31st at 1:00 pm

There will be no parking along the streets of the festival footprint once the streets are closed. We would also like to make you aware of a few other areas that will have NO PARKING along the streets during the festival set up and throughout the weekend. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED.

NO PARKING on the following streets:

Beginning Thursday, May 30th at 5:00 pm:

- West Main Street (between Cherry Street and the Square)
- East Main Street (between Walnut Street and the Square)
- North Market Street (between Water Street and the Square)
- South Market Street (between Franklin Street and the Square)

Beginning Friday, May 31st at 1:00 pm:

- Water Street (between Short Street and Mulberry Street)

- West Franklin Street (between Cherry Street and Market Street)

All streets and parking lots will re-open the morning of Monday, June 6th.

If you have **designated off-street parking (driveway, designated parking spots)** within the venue and wish to acquire a parking pass, please contact the festival office at 937-339-7714 or send an email to manager@gostrawberries.com. This pass will allow you to have access to your driveways, parking lots, or garages that you currently are permitted to park. **These parking passes will allow you to access the side streets so you can access your current off-street parking.** Be prepared to show your parking pass to festival security for access to your property. Parking passes will be available for pickup after May 13th at the Troy Area Chamber of Commerce office.

Please note there is NO on-street parking inside the venue footprint.

The Troy Strawberry Festival wants to thank you for your understanding and cooperation this year. We hope that you will join us in celebration of the festival's 48th year on the 1st and 2nd of June and at our hometown celebration, Strawberry Jam, on May 31st.
